Thank you for your interest in The Courtyard's production of *Great Expectations*, which will take place at The Courtyard Centre for the Arts, Hereford, in October 2019 (rehearsals starting mid-September). This page provides some general information about the production, the auditions and The Courtyard.

Background

The Courtyard is staging Nick Ormerod and Declan Donnellan's adaptation of Charles Dickens' Great Expectations as its third pro-am production. The past two pro-ams - Lord of the Flies and Pride and Prejudice - successfully brought together professional actors, members of the Herefordshire community and The Courtyard's own youth theatre to create projects that not only led to productions of great quality but which also contributed to The Courtyard's talent development programme in which the professional actors passed on vital skills to the youth theatre. We are confident our production of Great Expectations will emulate and surpass the successes of our two previous pro-ams.

<u>The Cast</u>

We are now seeking two professional actors to play Magwitch and Miss Havisham, and possibly some other minor roles, depending on the needs of the production. The casting breakdown is overleaf.

The Courtyard

The Courtyard is Herefordshire's major centre for the arts. It is a 16-year-old building near the centre of Hereford and comprises a 400-seat main house, 120-seat studio, café bar and restaurant, a gallery, workshops, rehearsal spaces and meeting rooms. The Courtyard has an excellent reputation for in-house productions, which in the past have ranged from full-scale musicals to Shakespeare, comedy and original pantomimes and national tours.

Male	
Playing age:	40-60
Height:	5'8" - 6'2"
Physical appearance:	Strong, brutish look, a hardened convict from the East End of London.
Accent:	Strong Cockney accent
Character:	A hard looking and strong individual, not afraid to get his hands dirty or even commit a crime in order to survive. He is a man who has not been given the best start in life and from a hard background. He goes through a big change as the story unfolds and, despite his harsh treatment from life and the law, is able to recognise kindness and repays the good that is shown him.
Skills:	The performer will need experience of working with young people of all ages and abilities, have a very strong physical ability and awareness of movement. A level of stage combat will also help. Strong vocal ability will also be key especially when passing on techniques to the young performers.

MISS HAVISHAM Female	
Playing age:	40-60
Height:	5'2"-5'8"
Physical appearance:	A worn, feeble, slim and ill looking woman
Accent:	Heightened RP
Character:	A woman once jilted at the altar who tries to manipulate and control everyone and everything around her. She is not well and is slowly becoming more unstable and in need of controlling others around her. Very weak and mentally tortured; she is in a constant state of anxiety.
Skills:	The performer will need experience of working with young people of all ages and abilities, have a very strong physical ability and awareness of movement.
