- The 'humming' sound of the hoist as it moves along:



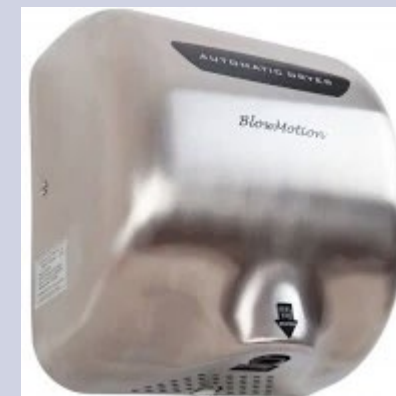
- The sound of water running from the tap:
